The mission of Rachel's Ballet JCT/PPDC Program is to provide competition experiences that will help students succeed in the field of professional dance (should they choose to pursue this career). Professional dance is one of the most competitive fields and requires dancers to be extremely dedicated and strive for artistic and technical brilliance.

Students invited to apply for PPDC have exhibited talent and dedication in classes, exam results, and performances (Nutcracker/Showcase). It is an honor to receive an invitation to join the company!

Policies and Procedures

Students and parents should understand the serious commitment of time, energy, and resources the JCT/PPDC requires before agreeing to participate.

- Each coach is responsible for coordinating the activities and needs of her/his own groups and soloists.
- Parents and dancers will check our website: <u>rachelsballet.com/PPDC-info</u> for periodic updates.
- All students and parents are expected to be supportive of each other and work as a team!
- Specific competition days and times are decided by the venue and may take place during school hours.
- Excellent attendance to all dance classes and JCT/PPDC rehearsals is required.
- Dancers must pay for each competition entry, even if a dancer becomes injured or sick.
- All dancers will compete in 3 competitions during the season (more for selected soloist).
- Potential soloists must audition to be considered.
- All Solos/Duos/Trios must also participate in an ensemble (group) piece.
- Contemporary/Hip Hop/Jazz soloists must be enrolled all year in a class of the same style.
- All JCT/PPDC members are required to take Contemporary and/or Acrobatics.
 - o Grade 4 and below are REQUIRED to take Acrobatic Arts (Jazz / Lyrical may be substituted if conflict)
 - o Grade 5 and above are REQUIRED to take Contemp. Class (both Acro and Contemp. recommended)
- If your dance or group is invited to finals or a prestigious competition event*, each family is fully responsible for their dancer's own travel/lodging/other expenses.

Tuition & Payments (cont.)

^{*} Please understand being invited to the final round is an honor and privilege; dancers must agree to participate if their ensemble is invited. Anyone injured or replaced will pay for an understudy to fill in. If invited to finals, the team will all chip in to compensate the coach(es) for their expenses (e.g. airfare/hotel/additional time). This is understood in advance.

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- Membership: There is a \$150 JCT/PPDC Membership Fee per dancer to help cover administrative costs.
- Rehearsal Fees: We will adjust according to table above if the number of dancers changes during the year.
- **Payments:** The first installment is due before Aug or before your June/July soloist summer choreography, Commitment is for the entire season; there are no refunds.
- Costume Fees: Approximately \$100/costume (most common) to \$450 for specialty costume (Vocational dancers)
- Competition Fees: Approximately \$45/dancer per ensemble and \$100/dancer per solo (exact fees available in fall)

Rehearsals

• Please see the RB website for PPDC schedule rehearsals dates for 2024-2025. **Dancers must also be registered for their regular ballet classes to participate.**

Competitions

- Our PPDC Coordinator will register all competitions. Parents are not to register their dancers in competitions.
- Competition deadline by our PPDC coordinator registrations is Sep and soloist by July.
- Rachel's Ballet will invoice parents for actual competition fees. You must pay by cash, check or online by due date.
- Failure to submit competition payment by the due date may result in withdrawal from the competition.
- There are no refunds available after a dancer is registered for any competition.

Absences

- Excellent attendance is required. After three (3) unexcused JCT/PPDC absences, dancers may be asked to leave.
- Ms. Rachel and the coaches MUST be informed at least 48 hours in advance of any known absences.
- For excused absences, the coaches must approve make-up classes, or a private lesson must be arranged to make up for choreography/work missed. Make-up classes must be fulfilled before the Annual Showcase in May.
- Punctuality is critical; all students must arrive before the specified call time for rehearsals and performances.
- No JCT/PPDC rehearsals during Nutcracker, scheduled studio breaks, Showcase and competition days/weekends.
